PRESENTATION & DISCUSSION OF COMMUNITY INTEGRATION LEADER (CIL) PROJECT FINDINGS	<ul> <li>Committee members viewed a PowerPoint presentation outlining the findings from the CIL Project including the results of the pre project Network Mapping Survey.</li> <li>Carrie Seward (Ministry of Children and Youth Services [MCYS]) will be meeting with the CIL Project Team before Friday's Wrap Up Event to discuss Niagara's project.</li> <li>While the project timeline has been very strict the achievements that have been made by the community have been substantial over the six month project.</li> </ul>	
3.	MOVING FORWARD WITH BSCFCRG BEYOND THE CILPROJECT	<ul> <li>The Niagara Aboriginal Children's Planning Council (NACPC) will continue to conduct their work as experts within their community. While they will no longer complete their community integration work under the auspice of the CIL Project they will maintain their relationship with and representation at the BSCFCRG table.</li> <li>Both the Fort Erie and Fairview Community Committees will continue to meet and report their progress to BSCFCRG.</li> <li>The CIL Project has been the focus of BSCFCRG for the past six months. Moving forward this committee will discuss the possibility of conjoining with the Hub Committee to create one table.</li> <li>A subcommittee has been created to look at a possible terms of reference and outline what this new table will look like.
